IOSSC SHIPPING FEES

As you are all aware the World Pilot Gig Championships on the IOS has been cancelled. Whilst it's a massive disappointment we all understand why.

With this, the shipping of the gigs has only partially taken place (18 gigs in total were shipped and 6 have been shipped back from the islands, with lockdown and only essential journeys, the decision by all (clubs, IOSSC and Justin) was that the gigs remain on the islands for the current time). PLEASE NOTE – Justin has moved all the gigs that are on the islands so that they are not in direct sunlight.

The IOSSC have made the following decisions for all clubs regarding their shipping. There are two options:

1. You can leave your shipping fees with the IOSSC and this will be carried across for future shipping
2. You can have a refund of your shipping fees
